

"In accordance with the recently approved Ross Township Park Redesign Master Plan and 5-year Recreation Plan with Michigan Department of Natural Resources, Ross Township invited public comment as plans proceed to implement the automated pay station and entrance and exit gates at Ross Township Park.

The drawings were posed last year in the park during the Truck n' Tunes public events. Submitted feedback written by the community was incorporated to develop the finial Master Plan in which the Automated pay station and gate is part of. These events were attended by a total of 600 community citizens. The final approved master drawing of the park redesign will be available at the Special Meeting for comment on the gate installation portion of this plan.

Ross Township Parks and Recreation committee is seeking \$40,000 in grant funding from the Michigan DNR Trust to proceed with the build and installation of the pay station and gate entrance/exit. Daily parkers will pull into entrance lane, and pay a flat fee at the pay station. Upon payment, receipt will print and pay station will vend gate allowing entry. The exit gate will be equipped with a "free-out" function.
