**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED**, that the following Poverty Level income Standards and Asset Level Test for Property Tax Exemption Guideline for Tax Year 2022 are hereby adopted:

3	\$21,960
4	\$26,500
5	\$31,040
6	\$35,580
7	\$40,120
8	\$44,660
For each addition person	\$ 4,540

- \*Claimant may not own more than one (1) vehicle per licensed driver in household.
- \*Claimant may not exceed \$10,000.00 of value of assets, excluding homestead and vehicles.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the Ross Township Board.
