Ross Township is looking for interested applicants to fill one **Planning Commissioner** position for a two-year term beginning January 1, 2023, ending December 31, 2024. This position is appointed by the Township Supervisor with approval of the Ross Township Board of Directors. **The Planning Commission is an independent decision-making body separate from the Ross Township Board of Directors.**

Applicants must possess genuine interest in zoning and planning matters in Ross Township, and be willing to put in the time necessary to carry out the duties of the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission consists of seven (7) members, including one Board Liaison member from the Township Board. **The Planning Commission's main duties include the following:**

- 1) Developing and overseeing the implementation of Ross Township's Master Plan;
- 2) Recommending revisions to the Zoning Ordinances to the Township Board;
- 3) Reviewing rezoning requests and making recommendations to the Township Board for a final decision;
- 4) Reviewing site plan applications;
- 5) Reviewing Special Land Use requests.

The Planning Commission meets on the fourth Monday of each month at 6:00pm. The Planning Commission may also hold additional Special Meetings when needed. **Planning Commissioners** are paid a set fee of \$100 for each meeting attended.
