Committee Reports:

Fire Board: Trustee Langshaw gave the Board members a copy of the retyped Interlocal Agreement with the Village of Augusta, to review and any comment or changes they recommend should be sent to Trustee Langshaw, within the next ten (10) days. There will be a Fire Board meeting in the next couple of weeks to review changes made and then a joint public meeting will be held with the Village of Augusta's Council and Ross Township Board.

Police Department: Chief Brown updated the Board; the State of Michigan audit went well last month. There were a few areas that require addressing, and he is the process of handling those items to satisfy the State requirements. Chief is also working with the DNR, to sudy possible on possibly expanding increasing the no wake zone in the bay. Trustee Sulka, noted that the last time this was done, there were several public hearings involving the Township Board and the DNR, with both proponents and opponents present.

Fire Department: Chief Bogema updated sthe Board; the Department had seventeen (17) calls over the pasts month. On April 14, 2024 the Fire Association is having a retirement party for Sydnee Genung and CraigFred Perkins. They will also celebrate Brandon Shirely and Isaac Schumaker becoming full Firefighters. The siren in the Village of Augusta is repaired and he is getting a quote on repairing the siren by the Island landing.

Old Business:
